Horizon 2020 funding for Dutch projects

As part of the European Commission's [action plan](#) to tackle COVID-19, €1 billion has been set aside for research through the Horizon 2020 programme. So far, [€602.3 million](#) has been awarded for research and innovative projects that address various aspects of the pandemic. Some of this funding has been awarded to Dutch universities, research centres and other organisations.
